

GUIDELINES AND TERMS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE SOS APPROACH TO FEEDING TRAINING PROGRAM

1. DESCRIPTION OF THE TRAINING PROGRAM

The SOS Approach to Feeding training program is provided in two parts:

- The pre-recorded portion of the training, consisting of 6 chapters, with a total duration of 9 hours including lectures and clinical case videos.
- The in-person training (October 29 - November 1, 2026) which includes lectures, clinical videos and case presentations, group activities, and hands-on practice with food.

2. GENERAL TERMS OF PARTICIPATION AND CERTIFICATION

100% participation is required in the SOS Approach to Feeding training program. In-person attendance is required on all 4 days at the training venue for all participants in the educational program.

In order to achieve the intended learning outcomes, fulfill the completion requirements for the SOS Approach to Feeding, and receive CEUs (Continuing Education Units), participants are required to complete the prerequisite, 9-hour pre-recorded portion and subsequently attend the entire educational program each day (October 29 - November 1, 2026, from 9:00 AM to 6:30 PM on Days 1-3 and from 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM on Day 4) to receive the Certificate of Completion and be permitted to use the SOS Approach to Feeding program.

3. PRE-RECORDED ONLINE PORTION (PREREQUISITE)

Enrolled participants will receive an email from the SOS organization (Toomey & Associates) with instructions on how to access and complete the prerequisite, 9-hour pre-recorded online portion of the SOS Approach to Feeding training program by September 6, 2026. The email sender address will be: info@sosapproach.com. The pre-recorded material is available exclusively in electronic format. For participants who have selected interpretation, the material will be provided in Greek, while for those who have not selected interpretation, it will be provided in English.

Attending and successfully completing the pre-recorded online portion (9 hours) is a prerequisite for participating in the in-person training. It includes 6 chapters that each enrolled participant must watch independently. Additionally, each participant must successfully pass a multiple-choice quiz for chapters 2 through 6 with a score of at least 80% IN ORDER TO BE ALLOWED to attend the in-person portion of the program. The online portion must be completed at least ONE WEEK PRIOR to the 1st day of the in-person portion, specifically by October 22, 2026. In the event of a failed attempt on a required quiz (score below 80%), the system will provide

instructions on how to review incorrect answers and retake the quiz a second time. If a participant fails a required quiz a second time, the system will notify the administrators at Toomey & Associates so they can reach out regarding any issues and provide instructions for a 3rd attempt. Participants who fail a quiz for the 3rd time will not be eligible to participate in the in-person portion of the program.

4. IN-PERSON TRAINING

4.1 Venue & Educational Material

The Training is scheduled to take place at a suitable conference venue located in the broader area of the capital. The exact venue, which will meet the high standards of DIEPISTIMONIKO KENTRO IPEIROU and will be determined by the final number of participants, will be communicated to attendees at least one month prior to the start of the Training.

The in-person training material will be distributed exclusively in printed format. For participants who have selected interpretation, the printed material will be provided in Greek, while for those who have not selected interpretation, the material will be provided in English.

4.2 Schedule & Attendance Requirements

During the in-person portion of the training program, participants must attend and fully participate throughout the entire duration of each training day (October 29 - November 1, 2026, from 9:00 AM to 6:30 PM on Days 1-3 and from 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM on Day 4) in order to receive the Certificate of Completion. Participant check-in begins at 7:00 AM on Thursday 10/29, at 7:30 AM on Friday 10/30 and Saturday 10/31, and at 7:00 AM on Sunday 11/1. Specifically for the final day of the training (Sunday 11/1), participants are kindly requested to account for additional time after the conclusion of the seminar when planning their departure, to allow for certificate distribution and general administrative processing. Those wishing to receive Continuing Education Units (CEUs) are required to successfully complete, with a score of at least 80%, each of the multiple-choice quizzes administered at the end of each day of the in-person portion.

Missing any part of the training program will result in losing critical information necessary for the proper implementation of the SOS Approach to Feeding program. Participants are asked to ensure timely arrival at the in-person seminar and remain for its full duration. Participants who arrive late or leave early on any day **MUST** make up the missed time; otherwise, they will not receive a Certificate of Completion and will not be authorized to use the SOS Approach to Feeding Program. In the event of a late arrival, the participant must immediately coordinate with Dr. Toomey to stay late each training day to make up all lost time.

Participants **MUST** arrange their travel and departure so that they arrive promptly before the scheduled start times and depart at the scheduled conclusion times. It is explicitly clarified that **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE** due to flight, train, bus schedules, or any other form of transportation.

4.3 Dietary Requirements & Allergies

Participants with specific preferences are welcome to bring additional snacks to satisfy their needs and supplement the provided items.

5. PRIVACY POLICY (GDPR)

Enrolled participants understand that by registering for and attending the SOS Approach to Feeding training program, their contact details will be shared with Toomey & Associates to create an account on Toomey & Associates' online learning platform for access to the prerequisite, 9-hour pre-recorded online portion, and they consent to the use of their contact details for this purpose.

Participants understand that upon registering for and attending the SOS Approach to Feeding training program, both DIEPISTIMONIKO KENTRO IPEIROU and Toomey & Associates have access and permission to contact them by phone, post, or email. Upon full completion of the SOS Approach to Feeding training program, participants may request the deletion of their contact details from DIEPISTIMONIKO KENTRO IPEIROU and Toomey & Associates at any time. Contact details will not be shared with third-party organizations and will only be used to verify training completion, to inform about additional training opportunities through DIEPISTIMONIKO KENTRO IPEIROU and Toomey & Associates, and to provide support resources for professionals following the program.
